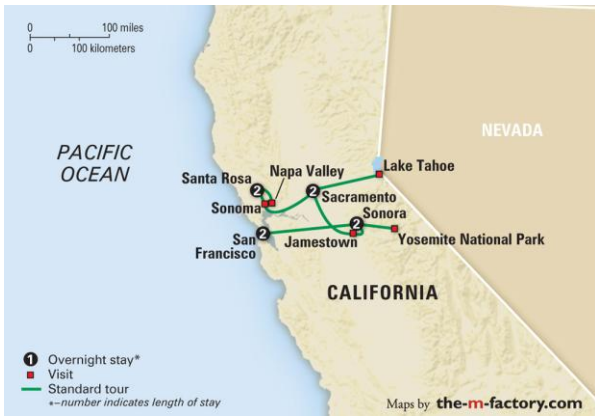

Day 6: Thursday, April 18, 2013

Sonora - Jamestown - Sacramento

Travel to Jamestown to visit Railtown, an 1897 state historic park featuring turn-of-the-century locomotives and railcars. A popular spot for movie makers, *High Noon*, *The Virginian*, and *Petticoat Junction* were filmed here. Arrive in Sacramento for a panoramic tour including the historic Governor's Mansion where Ronald Reagan once resided, and the State Capitol building. Then continue through Old Sacramento's historical district with over 60 restored gold rush-era buildings, wooden sidewalks, cobblestone streets and antique gas lamps for a glimpse at what life was like when thousands of "49ers" flocked here during the California Gold Rush. You'll have plenty of time to visit the unique shops. This evening, enjoy a fine dining experience along with "wine education" on the Delta King. This stationary restaurant on the Sacramento River is an authentic 285 foot riverboat, christened in 1927. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 7: Wednesday, April 19, 2013

Sacramento - Lake Tahoe - Sacramento

Travel over the Sierra Nevada Mountains to the resort gambling town of Lake Tahoe. Upon arrival, enjoy a narrated cruise of spectacular Lake Tahoe aboard the M. S. Dixie II paddlewheeler. Later, make a quick visit to a nearby casino to try your luck or explore the shops before returning to Sacramento. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 8: Saturday, April 20, 2013

Sacramento - Sonoma - Santa Rosa

A visit to Sacramento is never complete without a stop at the California State Railroad Museum, considered to be one of the best railroad museums in the United States. Enjoy the detailed exhibits and the many historical stories told by your museum guide. Later, take the short drive to Sonoma County, home to one of California's most fertile wine-growing regions. Special stops will be made at a local winery for a tour and tasting and at an olive oil press for the wonderful opportunity to sample many types of fresh olive oil. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 9: Sunday, April 21, 2013

Santa Rosa - Napa - Santa Rosa

A unique highlight awaits as you travel through California's treasured wine vineyards and arrive in Napa, one of the world's premier destinations. Breathtaking views abound. Sample several different wines before boarding the elegant Napa Valley Wine Train. Once aboard, sit back and relax as the incredible scenery, famous vineyards, and delicious meal complete the luxurious atmosphere. IMPORTANT RESERVATION INFORMATION

PASSPORTS & VISAS

Obtaining the proper proof of citizenship for entry to destination countries is the responsibility of each client.

A valid 10 year machine readable passport is required for each individual travelling outside of the United Kingdom. Passports must be valid for at least eight months beyond the return date from the destination.

Some countries require a visa in addition to a valid passport for entry into the country. It will be necessary for you to check with the appropriate embassy or consulate for specific information and entry requirements. Upon request, we can forward a visa application from a recommended visa service.

As some countries require your passport to be kept with you at all times as a form of identity, please ensure you keep it on your person in a safe and secure place. If your chosen destination does not require you to carry your passport, please ensure you leave it in a secure place, such as a hotel safety deposit box.

It is sensible to keep a separate note of your passport number and date of issue, therefore we recommend that our clients travelling abroad take a photocopy of their passport and applicable visas. These should be packed separately from your actual passport and visa. We also recommend leaving a copy at home with your chosen emergency contact. Please remember to complete the details of two relatives or friends who may be contacted in an emergency on the inside back cover of your passport.
